


How do we get a driver's license in Israel?

Age 16.5 ----

- Theoretical test
- At least 28 driving lessons by professional instructors
- Driving test

- At the age of 17 a driver license can be obtained
- Followed by a 3 months phase of accompanied driving






The Problem...










Number of accidents per year by driver class


Accidents cost per year by driver class (\$)




Event Distribution by Time of Day


Event correlation between parents and their young drivers
